Elizabeth S. Cooper Memoirs, 1931-1932

It is believed that Elizabeth Simpson Cooper was born around 1840. In 1931, at the age of 91, while living in Nebraska City, Nebraska, she began to write her memoirs and worked on them for two years. This photocopy of the spiral-bound memoirs, donated to the UNT Archives by her granddaughter, Mrs. August Schreiber (Bessie Cooper Schreiber) of Dallas, consists of Mrs. Cooper's typed memories of her childhood and school days in Virginia, her church, Cooper family history, and the Civil War in Kansas. Her memoirs cover from about 1846 to 1932 and are mostly chronological.
