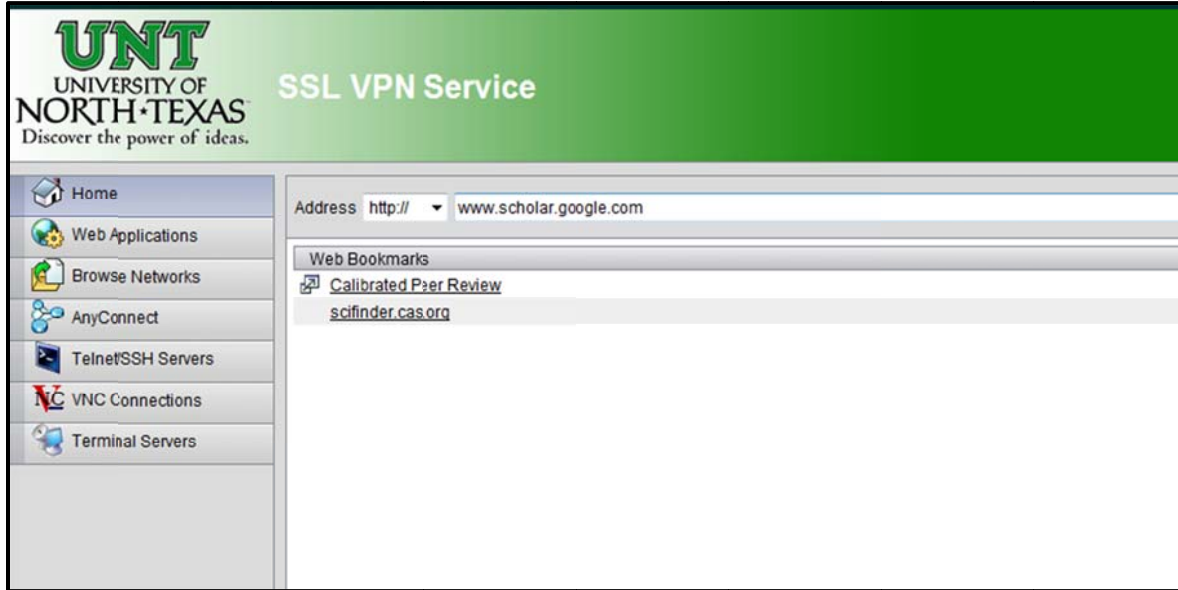
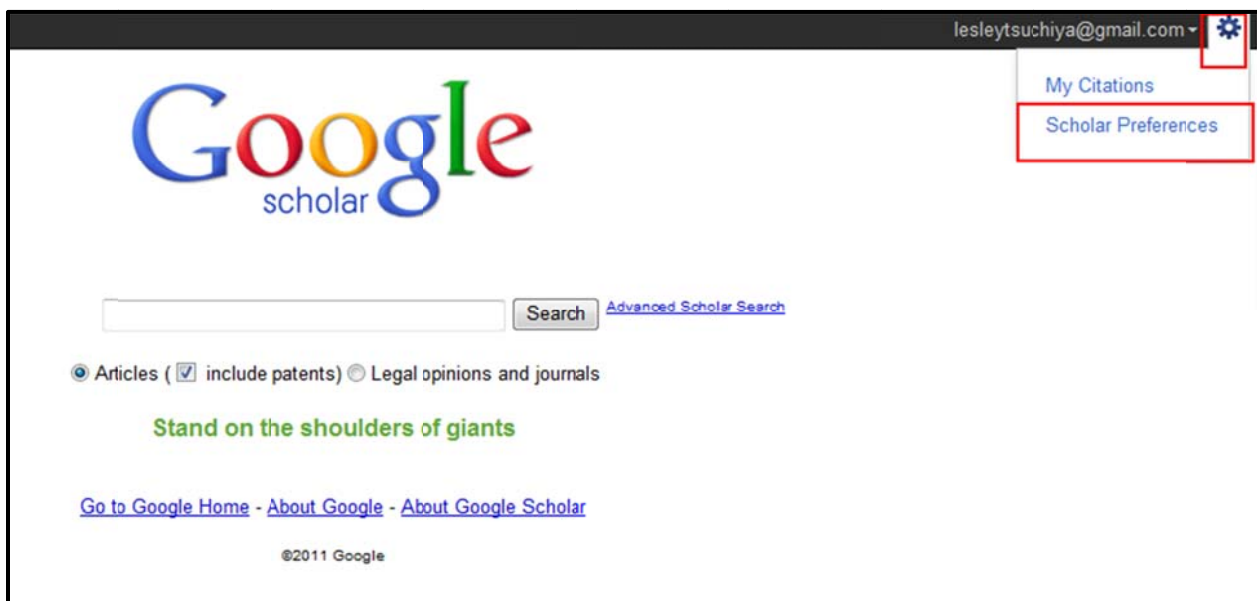




Use the VPN if you are searching off-campus. To log into the VPN, go to <http://vpn.unt.edu> and follow the prompts. VPN allows you to seamlessly access publications to which UNT pays for a subscription.



Once at the Google Scholar home page, click the gear icon which is hidden under the VPN tool bar so you will need to look carefully and select Scholar Preferences



**On the Scholar Preferences screen**, at Library Links type in University of North Texas click find library then select it by checking the check box. You can also search for other libraries you may have access to, such as your local public library and add them to your Library. However, not all libraries participate in Google Scholar so your local public library might not be available. Lastly, under bibliographic manager select the program you use. UNT's provides the RefWorks bibliographic manager for its students.

**Bibliography Manager**  Don't show any citation import links.

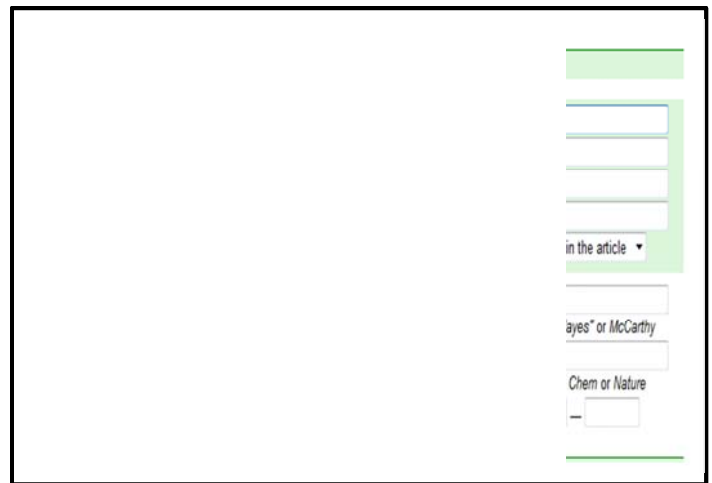

Once you set your preferences, you are ready to search Google Scholar. Google Scholar has basic and advance search options.

A search result from Google Scholar will look like the image below. Note the options below the citation: Cited by 38; Related articles; All 3 versions; and Import into RefWorks. Also note Full-Text @ UNT System to the right of the citation.

**Cited by 38** links you to other resources that have cited this reference.

**Related articles** links you to other articles similar to the one you found.

**All 3 versions** link you to various websites that house the article you found.

**Import to RefWorks** will import the reference into your RefWorks account.

**Full-Text @ UNT System** will connect you directly to the full-text version available at UNT. Note: this is only possible if you have logged in and are using the VPN.
