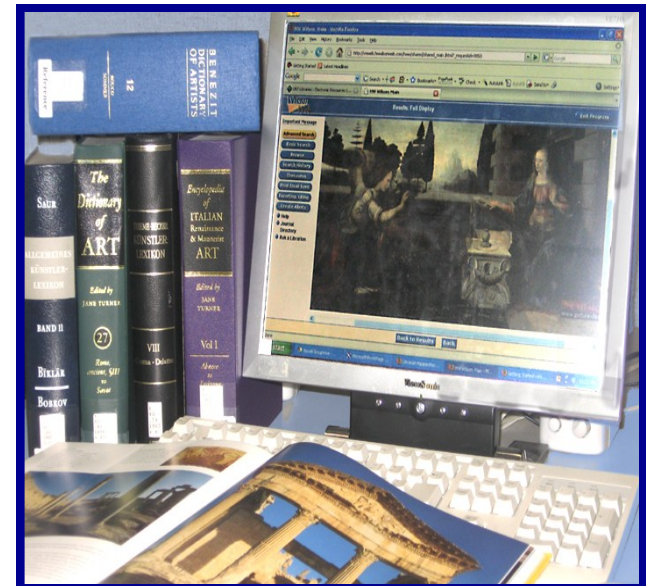

How to Find Art Books and Exhibition Catalogs in the UNT Libraries

Search the [UNT Online Catalog](http://www.library.unt.edu/)

<http://www.library.unt.edu/>

Choose the **Keyword** or **Subject** search.

***To find Artists:** Enter the last name, first name of the artist. Examples of a **Keyword** Search: Smith, Kiki; Belckner, Ross

***To find Exhibition Catalogs on individual Artists:** Search the name of the artist and the word exhibition. Ex.: Smith, Kiki and exhibition.

***Examples of other Art Keyword Searches:** gender AND art, feminism AND art, technology AND art, Postmodernism AND art, Reconstruction AND art. "Mona Lisa", da Vinci, Leonardo AND "Mona Lisa", "Mona Lisa" AND history, "Mona Lisa" AND historiography.

[Art & Architecture Complete](#) 1984-present

Art Abstracts offers journal articles from over 400 art and architecture periodicals published throughout the world. Subjects include Advertising Art, Antiques, Archaeology, Architectural History, Art History, Crafts, Decorative Arts, Folk Art, Graphic Arts, Industrial Design, Interior Design, Landscape Architecture, Motion Pictures, Museology, Non-Western Art, Painting, Photography, Pottery, Sculpture, Television, Textiles.

Art Bibliographies Modern 1980-present Includes all areas of art from the modern era (1850-present), with a particular concentration on photography. Contains abstracts of over

500 periodical articles, exhibition catalogs, and dissertations.

[Bibliography of the History of Art](#) 1973-present

The Bibliography of the History of Art (BHA), contains over 665,000 citations from 1,400 journals, conference proceedings, books, essays, dissertations, and exhibition catalogues. Subject coverage includes painting, sculpture, architecture, drawing, prints, and decorative and applied arts from antiquity to the present.

[Art Index Retrospective](#) 1929–1984

Contains citations of the printed art index from 1929-1984. Advertising Art, Antiques, Archaeology, Architecture, Art History, Crafts, Decorative Arts, Folk Art, Graphic Arts, Industrial Design, Interior Design, Landscape Architecture, Motion Pictures, Museology, Non-Western Art, Painting, Photography, Pottery, Sculpture, Television, and Textiles.

[Design & Applied Art Index](#) 1973-present

This is a great database to search for art journal articles about design, designers and the design world that are not found in most other art databases. DAAI contains over 100,000 references from more than 450 design and craft periodicals published 1973-1998.

JSTOR is all full-text and indexes thousands of journals in the humanities. JSTOR has the deepest archives of all databases. It may be necessary to use many keywords separated by "AND" to limit your search.
