Keyword search example: Balenciaga, Cristobal, Chanel, Coco; Chanel, Coco AND dress, Medieval AND clothing; Medieval AND fashion; "Art Deco" AND fashion; accessories AND Renaissance; shoes AND history.

The best fashion database. Contains encyclopedia articles, images of clothing and journal articles.

[Design and Applied Arts Index](#)

This is an excellent database for journal articles on design and designers.

[Art & Architecture Complete](#)

A good comprehensive art database with a lot of full-text journal articles. Coverage is 1984-present.

ARTstor is a digital library of over 1,000,000 high resolution images of art. To view costume and fashion objects choose "**Browse by Collection**", then "**Fashion, Costume, Jewelry**". Click on the plus "+" sign in the box beside "Fashion, Costume and Jewelry" and you will see these categories broken down by country. Click on the country to see all the fashion, costume and jewelry of that country. Also click "**date**" to organize the images by date.
